He met privately with NHA President and CEO Rudolph Johnson, III, and discussed the accomplishments NHA has achieved with the Head Start program, San Diego Food Bank, Service Employees International Union and other efforts since the new management assumed the helm of the large multipurpose social service agency in August 2006. Today, NHA serves over 10,000 children and families through its Head Start program, provides food and services to more than 1.9 million people each year, and successfully negotiated a three-year labor agreement with Service Employees International Union (SEIU). Today, the organization is poised to become the model human services organization in San Diego and the nation.
