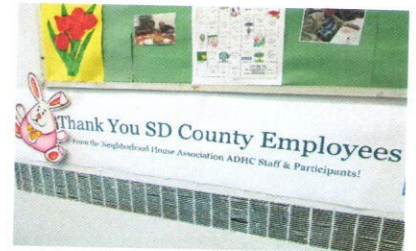

California COORDINATED

The state Medi-Cal program and the federal Medicare program have partnered to start a new project to improve care for seniors and and people with disabilities who are dually eligible for both of the public health insurance programs, "dual eligible beneficiaries". The California Coordinate Care Initiative (CCI) has two parts:

***Cal Medi-Connect:** Medi-Cal beneficiary's institutional and home-and community-based services will be **combined** into a single health plan.

***Managed Medi-Cal Long-Term Supports and Services (MLTSS):**Medi-Cal beneficiaries including dual eligible beneficiaries who have opted out of Cal Medi-Connect or who are not eligible for Cal MediConnect, **are required to join a Medi-Cal managed care health plan to receive their Medi-Cal benefits,** including long-term supports and services and Medicare wrap-around benefits.



Care Initiative Be on the Alert!

Duals subject to passive enrollment into Cal Med-Connect already in Medi-Cal managed care: A 90/60/30 day notices will be sent explaining choices plus a guide-book and Choice Form. Watch for a blue envelope. The social workers have attended training seminars and are available if you have any questions regarding this new program.


