Basic Job Assignment:

Under supervision of Program Director – ADHC, assists in providing Activities of Daily Living (ADL) care, including eating, bathing, dressing, toileting, and transferring, and assistance in assigned program activities.

Employment Requirements:

The ideal candidate is a self-motivated, team player who possesses a solid understanding of client care. The ideal candidate must have the ability to communicate using tact, objectivity, and confidentiality; demonstrate enthusiasm and motivate clients; is well organized and able to prioritize, plan, prepare, and follow through on assigned tasks in a thorough fashion; has excellent oral and written communication skills and the ability to understand/ carry out oral and written instructions; and has demonstrated experience working with culturally and ethnically diverse, low income or no income families and unique populations.

Qualifications:

- High school diploma or GED equivalent;
- A valid California drivers' license;
- CPR and First Aid Certification;
- TB Test required upon hire and must be maintained every three (3) years;
- Bilingual (English/ Spanish) preferred;
